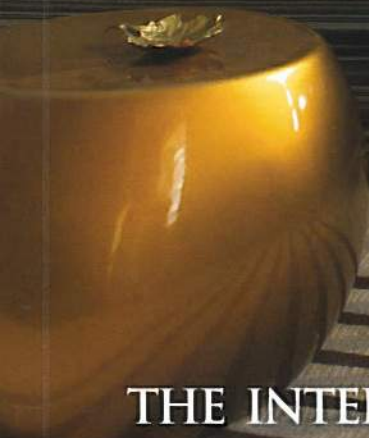
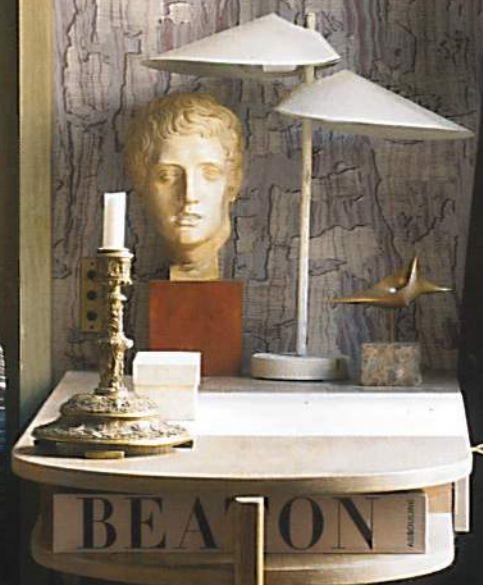

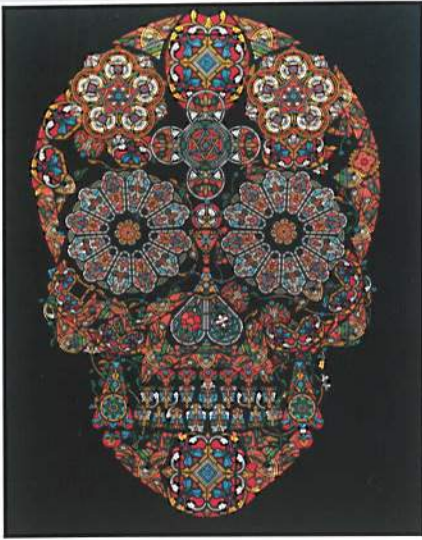

THIRTY YEARS on from his groundbreaking caricature puppet show *Spitting Image*, **Roger Law** has channelled his creative genius into a much more permanent medium, kaolin clay. Roger's ceramic collection evolved after his emigration to Australia where a local artist introduced him to the pottery workshops of Jingdezhen, China. His new artistic focus sees him incorporating an array of bizarre and unique Australia creatures and plants into bowls, pots and plates, resulting in a collection that is as witty and beautiful as his puppets were rude and ugly.
