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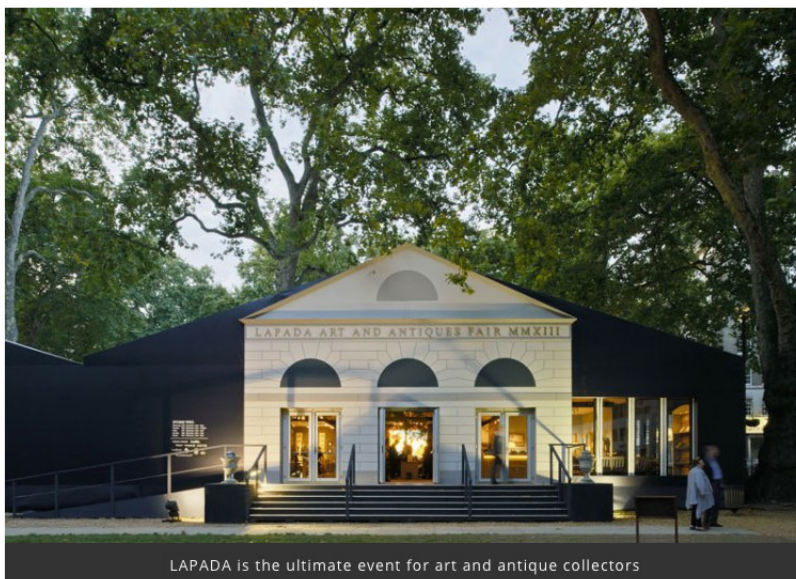

## 10 LAPADA Art and Antique fair, Berkeley Square

The LAPADA Art & Antiques Fair returns Berkeley Square, Mayfair, from 24th to 28th September, where over 100 dealers and experts will be selling furniture, jewellery, carpets, tapestries, antiques, clocks, ceramics, silver and fine art from Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> to Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> September. This is the sixth annual event, with 19,000 visitors from around the world attending last year, all hoping to pick up carefully curated items costing between £500 and £500,000. This year there will be added attractions coming from a Mr Fogg's pop-up venue within the LAPADA Fair. The bar's Victorian interiors, modelled on the drawing room of Phileas Fogg, will be recreated using stuffed tigers, vintage globes and trinkets collected from Fogg's journey, make an eclectic bar area for visitors to have drinks. Meanwhile, at The Brasserie, Event Oracle will be catering to a mix of fine-diners and those after a quicker bite, there will be a seafood bar and à la carte, as well as sandwiches and salads at The Café.
